**OBSERVATION:** Through interaction, it was understood that mostly the students had problems with grammar and basic sentence construction, which would help them think and write critically, as demanded by the course that they have undertaken. To estimate their grammatical prowess and to get hold of an idea of their expanse of their creative and critical thinking, it seemed best to me, as a mentor, to put the students through some exercises, especially composition-based ones. These demand thorough reading, understanding and writing skills.

The mentees have been graded after two comprehension exercises, where their writing skills and grammatical understanding were put to test. It can be seen from the corresponding grade chart, that the students have been somewhat inconsistent in dealing with the topics. The problems are, as predicted, gross grammatical errors and lack of understanding the topic. Many of the mentees have tried to copy the source text, almost word-for-word, and tried to answer the questions they were asked. A few of them, however, have chosen to think the topic(s) through and deliberated to-the-point answers, without choosing to write superfluously. And that has yielded with better results, as can be seen through the grade card.
