 - Since majority of the students are from the rural background and 1st generation learners effective psychological counselling is done to cope them with the prevailing environment. Students are free to discuss their problems and each mentor is committed to solve them in consultation with the Head of the Institution.
 - Direct involvement of students in day-to-day class activities, enriching them with skill of knowledge sharing and class room management.
 - Development of disciplined attitude.
 - Encourage Oral Expression Instead of Written Reports that would help them to appear before the interview board through debates, group discussions etc. It helps the students to become autonomous learners and agents of their own change.
