1. TITLE OF THE PRACTICE:

“GLORIOUS COMMUNITY SERVICES OF NSS VOLUNTEERS”

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE PRACTICE:

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a compulsory part of all Higher Education Institutions of India. Dr.Kanailal Bhattacharyya College has also dedicated wings of NSS Unit to serve the community and the Nation as well. The motto of NSS “NOT ME BUT YOU” has constantly driven the NSS volunteers to carry out their duties to the Nation throughout the year. The main objectives of the practice is to –

- a. Working with the people and for the people.
- b. Expanding one’s knowledge into the community.
- c. Finding the practical applications of one’s theoretical knowledge.
- d. Achieving the potential democratic leadership.
- e. Bridging the gap between the educated and uneducated.
- f. Channelizing one’s knowledge and skill to assist the weaker section of the society.

3. THE CONTEXT:

The NSS volunteers are dedicated to ensure the community service through various activities. There are 100 NSS volunteers and a Programme Officer under the NSS unit of the college. By the leadership of Programme Officer the NSS volunteers are regularly organized Health Check-up camp, Blood Donation camp, AIDS awareness camp, literacy camp in the local slum area.

4. THE PRACTICE:

There are two types of NSS activity- one is regular activities and the other is special camping activities. Under the regular activities the NSS volunteers are engaged to on campus activities like beautification of the college campus, college campus cleaning programme, AIDS awareness programme, Blood donation camp, celebration of important days like National Youth Day (12th January), Women’s Day(8th March) World Health Day(7th April), Fire prevention Day (14th April), Nutrition Week (1st to 7th May), World Environment Day (5th June), Banamahatsav Week(1st July to 7th July), Independence Day (15th August), NSS Day(24th September), National Integration Day(31st October), International Volunteers Day(5th December) etc. On the other hand under the Special camping activities they organized out outreach extension activities like Health check-up camp, literacy camp etc. in the local area.

5. EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS:

In the academic session 2018-2019 the NSS Unit of the college conducted the following activities –

6. PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED AND RESOURCES REQUIRED:

In the newly implemented CBCS Curriculum the NSS volunteers are always have to engage in their class attendance, project work, practical work, tutorial examinations. They do not have enough time to regular participation in various community services.

Limitation of fund is also a problem to serve the inhabitants of the slum area as their expectations.

If Government of India sanctions more funds for NSS Unit to serve the community, then it will be more fruitful.

1. TITLE OF THE PRACTICE:

CAREER ORIENTATED AND EMPLOYMENTGENERATION COURSEES.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE PRACTICE:

As an academic institution the college has a wider vision of social and economic uplipment of the people through value based quality education. The college also committed to serve the society with humility and trust, devoid of exploitation, to impart value based Higher Education. To ensure the enhanced skill of the student in the competitive professional field, the college has been introduced many career oriented and employment generation courses like Interior Decoration and Beautification certificate, diploma and advanced diploma course; Travel and Tourism certificate, diploma and advance diploma course, Basic computer education course, Tally and GST course and the Beauty therapy and Aesthetic Course under B.Voc Degree programme.

3. THE CONTEXT:

Most of the students are coming here from remote village. They belongs to economically poor and socially backward class. They need help for establishment after completion of general education. To develop their ability to perform minimum skill in small industries and to acquaint with the challenging field of profession, the college administration has offered them these career oriented courses.

4. THE PRACTICE:

As a general degree college there is no such scope to ensure the enhanced skill and orientation of the students in the conventional curriculum. Besides the general curriculum the college has been introduced these UGC Add-on course, career oriented duel degree programme (self-financing). All the 10+2 (or equivalent) passed students from any recognized Board can get chance to admission in these course. The course duration is as following:

Computer Skill Oriented Course

a. Tally ACE (Tally with GST)	60 Hours
b. Diploma in Computer Application (In collaboration with WEBEL Technologies Ltd.)	80 Hours

The Add-on courses and Tally ACE courses are running on only Saturday and Sunday from 2:00P.M. to 4:00 P.M. without hampering the general curriculum of the students. Beauty Therapy and Aesthetics (B.Voc) and Diploma in Computer Application courses are running with the general stream.

5. EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS:

After completing these types of skills courses, students can get a chance to work in various small institutes. During the last 2018-2019 academic year, three students of this college got jobs in A.K. Home solution after passing Interior Decoration courses.

6. PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED AND RESOURCES REQUIRED:-

Many of the students who come to this college are from poor families. For that reason, such efforts would have been more meaningful if they could have been provided with vocational education for free with more government grants.
