## **ACTION TAKEN REPORT**

## ON ALUMNI FEEDBACK 2017-2022

The IQAC of Dr. Kanailal Bhattacharyya College has given serious consideration to the Feedback System in pursuance of continuous improvement of quality of teaching-learning in the Institution. Online Feedback System was introduced in 2020-2021 session after pandemic. Physical inputs are collected from alumni regularly. The information generated through this system has been used as roadmap to address major issues raised by student alumni of the institution. The following table summarises the effort.
