TEACHER'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

SESSION 2019-2020

Teacher's feedback was collected from Full-time teachers (FTT) and State aided contractual teachers (SACT) of Dr. Kanailal Bhattacharyya College. A total of 41 teachers participated in the feedback process in 2019-2020 academic session. Major observations are listed below.

Survey Question	Response
1. How far the current teaching plan of your Department is satisfactory?	95.1% said that the teaching plan of the corresponding department is satisfactory. Only 4.9 % said it needs update and modification.
2. Do you use ICT enabled methods in teaching?	51.2 % said they use ICT tools in teaching on a regular basis. 48.8% said they use sometimes.
3. Do you explain course outcome and programme outcome to your students?	65.9% said they explain CO and PO regularly to students. 34.1 % said they do it sometimes.
4. Do you follow a mechanism to identify the weaknesses of your students and help to overcome them?	87.8 % said they regularly do. 12.2 % said they do not.
5. Do you participate in Departmental meetings to monitor and review the teaching learning process?	95.1% % said they participate regularly. 4.9 % said occasionally.
6. Do you encourage your students to participate in various extra-curricular activities?	100% teachers said that they motivate and encourage students regularly.
7. Are you satisfied with the books and journals available in College Central Library?	75.7% of the faculties said they are satisfied. 24.4% said they are still not satisfied.

Following suggestions were put forward by Teachers in their feedback towards improvement of overall academic activity of the college.

1. Better access to e-resources through library and subscription of new e-journals in library.
2. Increase in the numbers of ICT enabled smart classrooms and Installation of LCD projector
3. Purchase of new instruments and chemicals for science departments as per new CBCS curriculum.
4. Purchase of new text and reference books as per new CBCS curriculum.
5. Introduction of Seminal Library/Departmental library across all Departments.
6. Historical and heritage tourism for students.
7. Expansion of Computer/ IT laboratory with adequate facility for commerce.
8. Introduction of chemistry in UG programme.
9. Need to organize more student-centric activities like debates, student seminars, etc.
