TEACHERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

SESSION 2021-2022

Teacher's feedback was collected from a total of 40 Full-time (FTT) and State aided contractual teachers (SACT) of Dr. Kanailal Bhattacharyya College during 2021-22. Major observations are listed below.

Survey Question	Response
1. How far effective the current teaching plan of your department?	100% of the faculty said that the teaching plan of the corresponding department is effective.
2. Do you use ICT enabled methods in teaching?	50% said they use ICT tools regularly. 42.1% said they use sometimes. 3.9% said they do not use it.
3. Do you explain course outcome to your students?	73.07% said they explain CO to students regularly. 26.92% said they do it sometimes.
4. Do you explain programme outcome to your students?	61.53% said they do it regularly, 38.46% said they do it sometimes.
5. Do you follow a mechanism to identify the weaknesses of your students and help to overcome them?	76.92 % said they regularly do and arrange remedial classes while 23.07% said they do not.
6. Do you participate in Departmental meetings to monitor and review the teaching learning process?	84.6% said they participate regularly while 15.38% said occasionally.
7. Do you encourage your students to participate in various extra-curricular activities?	100% of the respondents said that they motivate and encourage students regularly.
8. Do you provide study materials to your students?	100% of the respondent said that they provide online and offline study materials regularly to students.
9. Are you satisfied with the books and journals available in College Central Library?	Only 3.84% said that they are highly satisfied, majority (76.9%) said they are moderately satisfied. 19.23% said they are not satisfied with the present collection of books and other resources in central library.

Following suggestions were put forward by Teachers in their feedback towards improvement of teaching learning process in their corresponding department:

1. CBCS semester wise new text and reference books needed in central library for commerce.
2. More full-time teachers across all departments.
3. ICT enabled smart classrooms in science block and extra-classrooms for commerce and science stream.
4. Expansion of computer/IT lab for commerce with more desktops.
5. Introduction of Seminal Library/Departmental library across all arts departments.
6. Better access to e-resources through central library and subscription of new e-journals in library.
7. Regular counselling to be arranged for students in campus.
8. More workshops and seminars per department.

Following suggestions were put forward by Teachers in their feedback towards overall improvement in college experience.

1. Curricular enrichment by introducing new UG courses (regular and add-on) for students.
2. More extra-curricular activities for students, particularly sports.
3. More community outreach programs.
4. Improvement in canteen service by providing wider variety of foods at low cost.
5. Full time librarian is urgently needed in central library.
6. Well-equipped locker system in teacher's staffroom.
7. Improvement of toilets for teachers in main campus and in science block.
